A note about subitizing: At it's core, subitizing is simply being able to recognize a group of objects without counting. This skill is a fundamental building block in establishing number sense, + building mental math abilities. Begin with the cards that have 5 dots or less, showing each card to your child for only 3 seconds. Remember, the idea is to be able to recognize the number without counting individual dots. After your child has become skilled at recognizing these cards quickly, add in a few more cards, mastering the new pile before adding more cards in later weeks.
